



## SUMMER INTERNSHIP PROGRAM



The Apollo Theater Academy Summer Internship Program provides rising high school seniors with opportunities for personal and professional development as they explore non-performance careers in the arts and entertainment industries. Through seminars, workshops, and hands-on training students experience a real world work environment, and connect with industry professionals.

Participants in the Summer Internship Program are also given the opportunity to broaden their knowledge of the Apollo Theater and the Harlem community. Over the course of the internship students come to understand the powerful ways that the arts impacts society and how they can make positive contributions to their communities through the arts.

Summer Interns are assigned to work alongside staff members of the Apollo Theater Foundation for six weeks in the following areas:

**Box Office, Community Outreach, Development, Education, Events Management, Information Technology, Marketing and Public Relations, Organizational Leadership, Programming, and Technical Production.**

Interns receive a small weekly stipend and are responsible for their own meals and transportation. If selected, interns must commit to attending the entire program and orientation sessions. Interns work Monday through Friday over the course of the six week program. Each workday consists of seven hours.

Students preparing to enter their senior year are welcome to apply to the Summer Internship Program in the Spring of their junior year.

Eligible applicants must have a:

- Valid New York State employment certificate (working papers).
- Valid Social Security card.
- Valid school ID card with a photograph.
- Recent school schedule and their most recent report card or transcript.
