Developed especially for high school students interested in the performing arts and improving their writing and analytical skills, Young Critics is a **free** 10-session after-school program held at BAM.

Classes will be held on Mondays, from October 17 to December 19, 2011, 4—6PM.

Students enrolled in this program:

- Participate in writing workshops
- Engage in lively discussions with peers
- Hone their critical writing skills
- Meet with professional critics and artists
- Attend live performances at BAM

An anthology of the students' writings is published at the end of the course.

Among the BAM Next Wave Festival productions being considered for this year's Young Critics program are:

- *69^o S.*, a theatrical look at the harrowing ordeal of explorer Ernest Shackleton that combines exquisite puppetry, stunning visual projections, and live music.
- *Canyon*, a new dance work by choreographer John Jasperse performed with live music; and
- *Krapp's Last Tape*, a one-act play by Nobel Prize-winning playwright Samuel Beckett, starring two-time Oscar nominee John Hurt (*The Elephant Man*, *Midnight Express*).

Young Critics is **free** for participating students. **Application deadline is October 10, 2011.**
