

## Summer assignment AP CSP summer 2019

Read and annotate the first chapter of "Blown to Bits" by Harry Lewis, Ken Ledeen and Hal Abelson. (Given to you at our June meeting AND available online for free on our Google Classroom). Have at least 10 comments and questions written on the printed text that you will bring to school on the first day for our discussion and have at least 5 questions written on the text that came up from your reading. Post at least one question to the summer discussion board (Google Classroom) and respond to at least 3 questions raised by at least 3 different classmates.

Make sure to have posted a question and respond to at least 3 classmates' questions in the online discussion by August 16.

Make sure that your "line" on the class page is complete before the first day of school.

1. This means that you have made all of your accounts and listed them (done at our June meeting)
2. Have tried Snap and have made a first project and shared and listed it on the class sheet (done at our June meeting)
- 3. Created a second new project, using at least 2 interactions and 5 programming blocks from at least 5 different block categories, which is fun and is linked to the class sheet (same way that we did the first project in June). TO BE DONE OVER THE SUMMER AND POSTED BY AUGUST 30.**

Extra credit: Code into your project: after you run the program, it resets itself and is ready to start again.
